PARENT / SPONSOR INFORMATION

Basic Entry Requirements:

- Bedding (pillow, duvet, fitted sheet – all for a single bed).
- Exercise book or two – preferably A4 – 96 pages.
- Pens.
- Bible.
- Toiletries (Soap, Shaving cream, Razors, Shampoo).
- If the resident is a smoker please provide cigarettes or money in the /tuckshop account. We will not supply cigarettes or any other luxury items on credit.

Phone Calls:

(Please note that all phone calls are at the Pastors discretion. Below are the standard guidelines)

- Residents will be allowed phone calls after 14 days of being in treatment.
- Phone calls are only allowed during the week (Monday to Thursday) between 17:00 and 21:00.
- Only direct family members (parents) or financial sponsors are allowed to call residents.

Visits:

(Please note that all visits are at the Pastors discretion. Below are the standard guidelines)

- Residents may receive visits after 21 days of being in treatment.
- Visiting hours are on Saturdays from 14:00 to 17:00
- Anything brought for residents (groceries etc) are to be handed to staff or management to be searched
- residents.
- Only direct family members (parents) or financial sponsors are allowed to visit residents.

Tuck Shop / Coffee Bar:

Walking With Winners offers a tuck shop which stocks very basic luxuries such as cigarettes and chocolates and chips. Money should be transferred into the bank account listed below. Please be aware that transfers can take up to 3 days to reflect in the bank account and credit will NOT be provided for residents. Please remember that you will not be speaking to the resident for the first 14 days of their stay.

PLEASE DO NOT GIVE RESIDENTS CASH AT ANY STAGE. CASH IS TO BE GIVEN TO LEADERS OR PASTOR DAVE OR ISOBEL DIRECTLY.

Medical Psychiatric:

- Walking With Winners is a drug free environment and the use of psychiatric drugs is prohibited unless prior written consent from Pastor Dave Barber is given. No exceptions will be made. We believe in giving the person the best possible chance of recovery.
